**Subject:** Submission regarding proposed variation of licence conditions – Alice Springs

To whom it may concern,

I am writing in support of the proposed variation of licence conditions.

I work in Alice Plaza and regularly experience the impacts of daytime drinking in the CBD. In the early afternoon, it is common to hear intoxicated people moving through the centre. This is a predictable occurrence and contributes to disruption and discomfort for workers and visitors.

While I recognise that the proposed changes will not address every issue, I believe they are a sensible step in the right direction. People should be able to have a drink with a meal, but where patrons are primarily drinking for extended periods during the day, limiting access to full-strength alcohol is likely to reduce the level of intoxication and its broader impact.
