Thank you for your letter outlining proposed changes to conditions of the Desert Oaks liquor license.

At the Board of Directors meeting on Tuesday 10th May 2022, the NPYWC Directors unanimously passed a resolution to support the changes to the liquor license as proposed by the licensee. The Directors also agree with and fully support the Commission's view that it is desirable to vary the license in similar terms and conditions in force at other licensed premises, for example Curtin Springs Roadhouse.
