REPORTABLE TRANSACTIONS

How do the changes affect you?

The Liquor Commission has imposed a condition on this licensee's takeaway licence that from **3 November 2020**, the licensee must advise Police of reportable transactions.

The types of purchases of liquor that are reportable are below.

For reportable transactions this licensee must record and provide to NT Police:

- Your name, age or general description including registration details and place of residence
- Details of what was purchased

A reportable transaction is defined as:

- Takeaway sales to any one person on any one day in excess of any of the following:
 - 3 cartons of full strength beer
 - 12 bottles of wine
 - 4 bottles of spirits
 - 48 cans or bottles of RTD's
 - Three or more takeaway liquor purchases of any kind by the same person in any one day
- Any other liquor sale which arouses suspicion that the purchaser will commit
 an offence by possessing, consuming or supplying liquor within all areas of
 the Pitjantjatjara, Ngaanyatjarra lands and all Aboriginal lands in the
 Northern Territory.
