Liquor Commission Act 2018

DELEGATION BY THE LIQUOR COMMISSION

The Northern Territory Liquor Commission, pursuant to section 37 of the *Liquor Commission Act 2018* and with reference to section 42 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, delegates its power and function under section 75(2) of the *Liquor Act 2019* to the Director of Liquor Licensing (the Director) to amend a licence to substitute other premises, subject to the limitations that the delegation only be exercised if:

- the application of a Licensee to substitute other premises for the licensed premises does not apply to a takeaway authority;
- the Director is satisfied that no significant change in the operation of the business will occur as a result of the substitution; and
- the substitution satisfies the public interest and community impact requirements.

This delegation takes effect from 11 March 2020.
