Liquor Commission Act 2018

DELEGATION BY THE LIQUOR COMMISSION

The Northern Territory Liquor Commission, pursuant to section 37 of the *Liquor Commission Act 2018* and with reference to section 42 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, delegates its powers and functions to determine under section 97 of the *Liquor Act 2019* an application for a material alteration to licensed premises to the person acting as or performing the duties of the Director of Liquor Licensing (the Director) on condition that the Director has referred the application to the Commission and the chairperson or a deputy of the chairperson of the Commission has declined to accept the Director's referral.

Compliance with the above condition is not required when the Director exercises a power or performs a function in accordance with the Commission's Delegation that came into effect on 4 July 2025.

This delegation is provided on the understanding that any decision made by a delegate is subject to the *Liquor Commission Act 2018* and the *Liquor Act 2019*.

This delegation takes effect from 5 July 2025.
